### NON-EXCLUSIVE ELECTRICITY SERVICE FRANCHISE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the resolution of HomeWorks Tri-County Electric Cooperative, a.k.a. Tri-County Electric Cooperative, for Grant of Electricity Service Franchise having been read and discussed by the Vernon Township Board at a meeting held on June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

#### BE IT RESOLVED:

A. A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE IS HEREBY GRANTED TO HOMEWORKS TRI-COUNTY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, its successors and assigns, for the right, power and authority to construct, maintain and commercially use electric lines consisting of towers, masts, poles, crossarms, guys, braces, feeders, transmission and distribution wires, transformers, meters, and other electrical appliances and attachments, on or under, along, and across highways, streets, alleys, bridges and other public places, and to do a local electric and associated business in Vernon Township, Isabella County, Michigan, for a period of thirty (30) years, subject to the following:

B. CONDITIONS: No highway, street, alley, bridge, or other public place used by said Grantee shall be obstructed longer than necessary during the work of construction or repair and shall be restored to the same good order and condition as when such work was commenced, at the expense of the *Grantee*. All towers, masts, poles and other supports shall be set and all wires shall be suspended or buried in a lawful and proper manner. The Grantee shall have the right to maintain its easements and system, and associated business, including the right to remove and trim trees and vegetation in the conducting of such business.

C: HOLD HARMLESS: The Grantee shall at all times keep and save the Township free and harmless from all loss, costs and damages to which it may be subject by reason of the negligent operation, construction and maintenance of the system, structures and equipment hereby authorized. In case any action is commenced against the Township on account of the permission herein granted, said Grantee shall, upon notice, defend the Township and indemnity from all loss, cost and damage arising out of such negligent operation, construction and maintenance.

The Cooperative may at its option, hereafter, seek an irrevocable franchise as provided by law, subject to Township board approval. The franchise granted by this Resolution is revocable as provided by law, provided revocation shall be for good cause only, and Grantee shall have no less than sixty (60) days to reasonably cure the same after written notification has been served upon Grantee.

WHEREAS, Township of Vernon, Michigan, is a political subdivision within the State of Michigan with an official Emergency Operations plan in compliance with Section 19 of the Emergency Management Act, Act 390, Pubic Acts of 1976, as amended.
